- Focus on your goals, not the tech
- AEM as a default

Quick Facts

- Approximately 32% of the internet is built on WordPress
- WP is open source that is built with PHP, Javascript and MySql
- Cru runs a multi-network, multi-site installation of Wordpress
 - We have over 135 separate web sites running in WordPress

- Used for more specialized/customized websites (e.g. Like Arrows Family Life)
- Content authoring at scale (e.g. campus sites)
- Many online resources for Wordpress available
